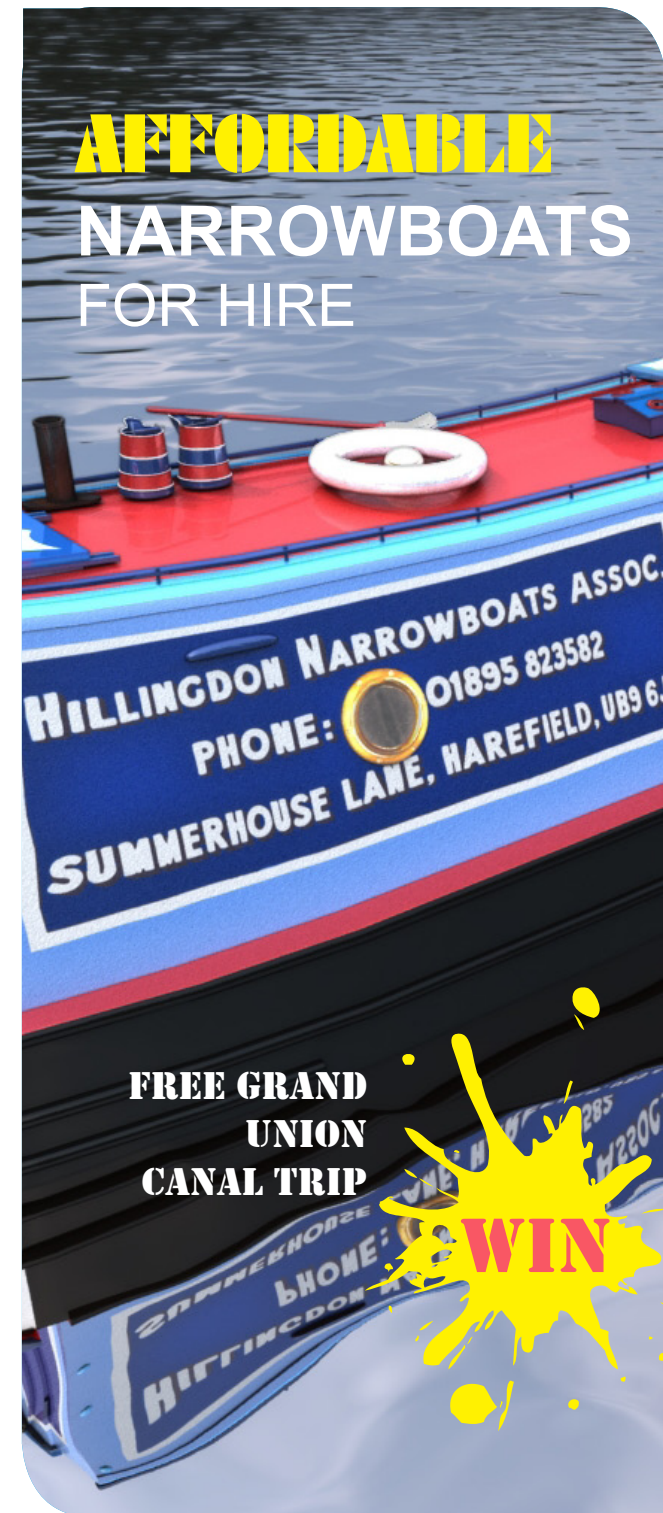

TEAM BUILDING



We aim to bring people together by developing their skills, learning from one another and realising their potential whilst maintaining and promoting the canal as a remarkable asset to our community.

On board our canal boats, we work in small teams (where the group is larger than 10 people, participants will be split across two or more vessels) on a range of navigational, mental and fun exercises. Teams can also compete competitively against each other, with prizes for the winning team.

Canal boat team building activities can include navigating locks, boat handling, commentary on surrounding area, cooking and serving meals for your group, photographing and a treasure hunt challenge en route.

TRAINING AT HNA



Our exciting and comprehensive HNA training programme takes two weekends to complete and includes food and on-board overnight accommodation.

Through this course successful trainees can qualify for a HNA Steerers Certificate, which will allow them to hire our boats and take them out independently.

This qualification also counts towards achieving a Certificate in Community Boat Management (CCBM) which is a Nationally recognised award.

The HNA course covers the following topics:

- Craft knowledge
- Practical boat handling
- Group management
- Theory
- Group Safety
- Assessment methods

Our courses are run in small groups of six to ensure a one-to-one experience. These training programmes are extremely popular so please contact us as early as possible to ensure your place on this course.
